Guest Speaker: Marie Romagnano, RN, BSN, CRC will conduct a 4-hour seminar for healthcare professionals on the Topic of: Spiritual Assessment of the Patient with JCAHO Guidelines -Developing Your Vocation as Healthcare Professionals for Divine Mercy. Auxiliary Bishop Ignatius Wang – He was ordained priest in July 1959. Following his ordination, he earned his degree in Canon Law at the Pontifical University in Rome. He came to San Francisco in 1974, after serving in Grenada for 12 years. He was appointed director of the Propagation of the Faith in 1992, and as chancellor in 2000. In January 2003, he was installed Auxiliary Bishop of San Francisco Archdiocese. He is spiritual director of Divine Mercy Eucharistic Society and member of the advisory board.

Fr. John Struzzo, CSC, has been ordained a priest of the Congregation of Holy Cross for 43 years. He has a Ph.D. in Sociology and a Post-Doctorate in Marriage and Family Therapy and Individual Psychotherapy. He has been involved in the healing ministry for the past 27 years. He has been active in evangelization and the healing ministry throughout the world. His concern is to boldly preach the truth in love, and to return to the basics of the Catholic Faith.

Mother Nadine Brown - In 1976, Mother Nadine was called out of the cloister in order to bring the rich heritage of contemplative spirituality and its fruits to everyone. In 1980, she founded the Intercessors of the Lamb for the purpose of continuing the redemptive mission of the Lamb of God through His powerful "burden-bearing" ministry of contemplative intercession and spiritual warfare. Mother Nadine is an author of three inspirational books, "Bathe Seven Times", "Interceding with Jesus" and "God's Armor". Mother Nadine and her Community of Intercessors are a shining light in a world of darkness. They are true warriors. They set upon an exciting course that dispels falsity with truth and darkness with love.

Monsignor James Lisante - is the pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Church in Massapequa Park, NY. He previously served as a Director of the Office of Family Ministry for the Diocese of Rockville Centre. Monsignor Jim has authored four books, including: *Of Life and Love, Let's Talk, Personally Speaking,* and *The Power of One.* Long active in the popular media Monsignor Lisante has hosted several national television programs including: *Personally Speaking* and *Christopher Close-Up.* He is currently in the process of launching a new television show, *Close Encounter,* which will appear nationally on PBS in the near future. He is also a regular contributor to *Fox News Channel* and *ABC Eyewitness News.* Msgr. Lisante has also appeared on **PBS, MSNBC, CNN** and **CBS** and **Nightline** with **Ted Koppel.** He currently hosts an annual **NBC Special** called *Personally Speaking.* Monsignor Jim is also the host of a weekly radio program called *Personally Speaking.* Monsignor Jim's columns have appeared in over 300 newspapers.

Fr. Stan Fortuna, C.F.R. – is one of the eight original members of the Community of Franciscan Friars of the Renewal established in the Archdiocese of New York in 1987. He founded *Francesco Productions,* a recording company to support their ministry to the poor. He is now involved full time in the preaching apostolate, using his gift of music as a powerful means to reach deep into people's heart and soul.

Marie Romagnano, RN, BSN, CRC – Founder of Healthcare Professionals for Divine Mercy and *Nurses for Divine Mercy* in response to the need for the spiritual care of the sick, injured and dying. This includes all professional medical fields that are incorporated as an official apostolate of the Marians of the Immaculate Conception in Stockbridge, MA. She wrote a book: *"Nursing with the Hands of Jesus: A guide to nurses for Divine Mercy"* to extensively examine the need for spiritual care of the patient. She currently works as a catastrophic injury nurse case manager in Boston, MA.

Salvatore Caruso, AIA – is a native of San Jose, CA. He attended the Institute of Architecture in Palermo, Italy. Two of his many projects that are close to his heart are directly connected to his Catholic faith: the renovation of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church and the Poor Clare Monastery in Los Altos Hills. Architect Caruso heads the Salvatore Caruso Design Corp. in Santa Clara, CA. He is the architect of the Divine Mercy Shrine Project and Vice-Chairman of the Board of Divine Mercy Eucharistic Society.
