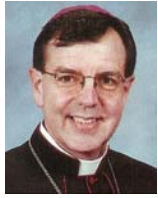

GUEST SPEAKERS



The Most Reverend Allen H. Vigneron – was named Coadjutor Bishop of Oakland Diocese in June 2003 by Pope John Paul II and later succeeded to the See of Oakland in October 2003. Prior to this he was Vicar General of the Archdiocese of Detroit. He also served on the staff of the Vatican Secretariat of State Office before being appointed in 1994 rector of Sacred Heart Seminary in Detroit, Michigan.

Auxiliary Bishop Ignatius Wang – He was ordained priest in July 1959. Following his ordination, he earned his degree in Canon Law at the Pontifical University in Rome. He came to San Francisco in 1974, after serving in Grenada for 12 years. He was appointed director of the Propagation of the Faith in 1992 and as chancellor in 2000. In January 2003, he was installed Auxiliary Bishop of San Francisco Archdiocese. He is spiritual director of Divine Mercy Eucharistic Society and member of the advisory board.



Fr. Michael Barry, SS.CC. – He was ordained in June 1964 as a member of the Congregation of Sacred Hearts. He was formerly the Provincial of his order in Western U.S. He is former director of the San Bernardino Diocese Charismatic Renewal Center and the Evangelization Ministries. He founded Mary's Table that provides food for the poor and Veronica Home, a shelter for single pregnant women. He has a special gift of healing. He is a Board member of DMES.

Salvatore Caruso, AIA – is a native of San Jose, CA. He attended the Institute of Architecture in Palermo, Italy. Two of his many projects that are close to his heart are directly connected to his Catholic faith: the renovation of Our Lady of Guadalupe Church and the Poor Clare Monastery in Los Altos Hills. Architect Caruso heads the Salvatore Caruso Design Corp. in Santa Clara, CA. He is the architect of the Divine Mercy Shrine Project and Vice-Chairman of the Board of Divine Mercy Eucharistic Society.



Fr. Kaz Chwalek, M.I.C. – is a member of the Congregation of Marians of the Immaculate Conception in Stockbridge, MA. He was ordained in 1987. He promotes the Divine Mercy message through conferences, seminars, radio and TV programs, especially at EWTN. His love for Pope John Paul II led him to be the editor of the English Edition of "The Making of the Pope of the Millennium: Kalendarium of the life of Karol Wojtyla".



Fr. Stan Fortuna, C.F.R. – is one of the eight original members of the Community of Franciscan Friars of the Renewal established in the Archdiocese of New York in 1987. He founded Francesco Productions, a recording company to support their ministry to the poor. He is now involved full time in the preaching apostolate, using his gift of music as a powerful means to reach deep into people's hearts and soul.

Rev. Msgr. Henry Posluszny – was an assistant parish priest in St. Faustina's home parish in Poland. He is an expert on the Divine Mercy messages which Jesus revealed to St. Faustina. He is a personal friend of St. Faustina's family. He spent the past twenty two years teaching at universities and seminaries in England and assessed the vocations of young men aspiring for priesthood.



Marie Romagnano, R.N. - she founded the "Nurses for Divine Mercy" in response to the need for the spiritual care of the sick, injured and dying. This includes all professional medical fields that is incorporated as an official apostolate of the Marians of the Immaculate Conception in Stockbridge, Ma. She wrote a book: "Nursing with the Hands of Jesus: A guide to nurses for Divine Mercy" to extensively examine the need for spiritual care of the patient. She currently works as a catastrophic injury nurse case manager in Boston, Ma.

Fr. Mark Wiesner – is the Pastor of St. Augustine's Church in Oakland, Ca. He was born in Buffalo, NY and moved to California with his family in 1969. He graduated from U.C. Davis in 1985 with a degree in Rhetoric and Communications. He was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Oakland in June 1995.
