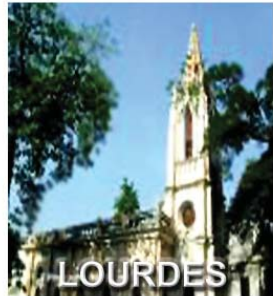


PILGRIMAGE TO MARIAN SHRINES OF EUROPE

TRAVEL ITINERARY OCT. 3 -18, 2007.

OCT 3, Wednesday – Departure at San Francisco Airport. Board a transatlantic flight bound for Barcelona. Dinner served on board.

OCT 4, Thursday - On arrival at Barcelona airport, meet by Travel Tours courier, coach driver and local English-speaking guide. Barcelona city tour. Transfer to Montserrat, Catalonia's most important shrine, where the Black Virgin is venerated since medieval ages. Dinner and overnight at Monserrat.

OCT 5, Friday – Breakfast. Mass and retreat at Monserrat. Free time for personal prayers.

OCT. 6, Saturday - Breakfast and after morning Mass, transfer to Zaragoza, where St. James had a vision of Our Lady standing on the pillar encouraging him to continue his apostolic mission in Spain. Guided city tour includes Plaza del Pilar and the spectacular La Seo. Dinner and overnight in Saragossa at the 4 star hotel. Dinner and overnight at Saragoza.

OCT. 7, Sunday – Breakfast and after morning mass, continue to Lourdes, the birthplace of St Bernadette to whom Our Lady appeared in 1858 near the Grotto of Massabielle. Relax before dinner, then followed by a candlelight procession. Dinner and overnight at the 4 star-hotel.

OCT. 8, Monday – Breakfast. During your stay in Lourdes, we celebrate Mass at the Grotto, we pray for the sick and drink water from the miraculous spring. Submerge yourself at the baths and visit the places connected with St Bernadette. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes.

OCT. 9, Tuesday - Breakfast and after morning mass, transfer to Garabandal. En route visit Loyola, the birthplace of St. Ignatius. Visit to the Basilica and the saint's family house. Dinner and overnight at the Posada San Miguel.

OCT. 10, Wednesday – Breakfast and mass. Full pilgrimage program in Garabandal. Explore the rural village, where in the sixties four children had apparitions of Our Lady who visited them, speaking, guiding and confiding secrets of future events. Visit the households of the visionaries converted into little museums, attend Mass and follow the Stations of the Cross. Dinner and overnight in Garabandal.

OCT. 11, Thursday – After breakfast and mass, transfer to Santiago de Compostela. According to legend, the bones of the Apostle St. James the Great were transported to Spain after his martyrdom in A.D. 44 and placed at the site of the Cathedral in the year 813. Dinner and overnight.

OCT. 12, Friday - Breakfast. Mass at the Cathedral followed by a guided tour. Travel to the medieval city of Santiago de Compostella. Continue your journey to Fatima, where the Blessed Mother appeared in 1917 to three simple shepherd, for 2 nights full-board

accommodation at the 4 star hotel. After dinner and settling into your hotel, you may relax or participate in a celebration of the 12th Fatima Feast, which includes the International Rosary in the Capelinia, Candlelight Procession and Concelebrated Mass at the outdoor altar.

OCT. 13, Saturday – Celebrate Our Lady of Fatima Feast. Today is the climax of our pilgrimage to Fatima. Enjoy the ceremonies of the feast: Eucharist, Blessing of the Sick and Adeus - farewell procession. In the evening after dinner, join pilgrims from around the world in an evening candlelight procession to pray the Rosary.

OCT. 14. Sunday – After breakfast and mass, continue to Avila, the birthplace of St. Theresa of Jesus, the great mystic and the first woman to be named Doctor of the church. Dinner and overnight in Avila. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

October 15, Monday – After breakfast, celebrate the Feast of St. Theresa of Jesus in Avila. Morning Mass at Convent of St. Teresa, and visit the birthplace of the great mystic and the first woman to be named a Doctor of the Church. We will also visit the Monastery of the Incarnation - a Carmelite convent where St Teresa remained for 30 years. Afternoon at leisure in Avila. Dinner and overnight in Avila.

OCT 16, Tuesday – After breakfast, travel to Alba de Tomes, and visit the monastery and museum, a place where the left hand of St. Theresa of Avila is kept. Celebrate mass at the monastery of alba de Tomes. Then proceed to Salamanca for city tour. Dinner and overnight in Salamanca.

OCT 17, Wednesday – After breakfast and mass, travel to Madrid, tour the city of Madrid. Dinner and overnight.

OCT 18, Thursday - Transfer to Madrid airport for return flight to USA.

BOOKING CONDITIONS

TOUR COST: Tour price is based on lowest airfares and currency exchange levels in effect at the time of booking. It is subject to adjustment in the event of significant changes in the exchange levels.

TOUR ARRANGEMENTS: Air transportation will be provided for transatlantic flight. Overnight accommodations will be provided in twin bedded rooms. Single room supplement is \$450. Unused accommodation and features of this tour are not refundable, nor

exchangeable for other services. The right is reserved to substitute hotels and sight seeing features if it becomes necessary.

NOT INCLUDED IN THE TOUR COST: Cost of passports, items of personal nature, phone calls, laundry, portorage at the U.S airports, optional insurance, additional meals/beverages, gratuities to guides and drivers.

BAGGAGE: Each person is allowed one piece of luggage free of charge. The maximum weight of luggage may not exceed 70 lbs. Baggage is carried at owner's risk.

DOCUMENTS: A valid U.S or foreign passport is required. Check the validity of your passport and be sure it is signed. Visas are not required for U.S. citizens.

CANCELLATIONS: All cancellations must be made in writing to Divine Mercy Eucharistic Society. Last day to cancel without charge will be July 6, 2007. After that period, \$250 will be assessed to cover processing and administrative expenses. No refund will be made for a cancellation received within 45 days prior to departure.

INSURANCE: All inclusive insurance is available and will be offered to all tour participants. Strongly recommended.
